Launching Brief

➔ PHASE 1: FOUNDATION LESSONS

Teach these lesson before launching Collaborative Learning:

- What is Independent?
- What is Engagement?
- Material Management
- Choosing a good fit S.P.A.C.E. to work
- Think: What Is My Purpose?
- Respectful Communication

➔ PHASE 2: 10 Steps to Collaborative Learning

Use the 10 Steps to Teaching and Learning Independence to launch Collaborative Learning:

- 1 | Identify what is to be taught:
Collaborative Learning
- 2 | Set a purpose: Create a sense of urgency
 - Be respectful to others
 - Learn more
 - It is fun
- 3 | Identify the behaviors of Collaborative Learning on I-chart
- 4 | Model most-desirable behaviors
- 5 | Model least-desirable behaviors, then most-desirable behaviors (same student)
- 6 | Place students around the room
- 7 | Practice and build engagement
- 8 | Stay out of the way; monitor student engagement
- 9 | Use a quiet signal- come back to group
- 10 | Self-Reflection: "How did you do?"
