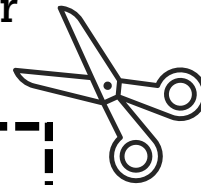


# The Life of Dr. Martin Luther King

In 1965, he helped to organize the Selma to Montgomery marches, which led to the Voting Rights Act.



In 1963, King led the March on Washington and delivered his famous "I Have a Dream" speech.



The first National Holiday to honor him was held in 1986.



In 1948, he graduated from Morehouse College and was ordained as a Baptist minister.
